

1: Use **Chat** system of ZOOM, **not Q&A** (**LIVE CONNECTION only**).

or

To panelists and audiences (all members in this room can read.)

Chair person will pick up the questions and give the speaker from the lists in Chat column. Even if the questions were not asked in the time period of live connection, those are given to the speakers later, and they will give their responses and shown in the second term, 16-18, December.


